OF CHAOS & REVOLUTION

Chaos continues to spread across North Africa and the Middle East. Libya's strongman Colonel Moammar Qaddafi – (one wonder's why all these colonels don't just promote themselves to General or Field Marshall or something) – has unleashed almost unlimited force against his own people – launching airstrikes against protesters. Two of his Air Force colonels have defected in protest against the orders.¹ As I write this, Qaddafi is on the verge of being removed. The influential Muslim scholar, Yusuf al-Qaradawi continues to fuel the flames of revolution, calling for the death of the Libyan leader.² In Cairo's Tahrir Square, Qadawi was allowed by the ruling military to preach jihad, suicide bombings against Israelis and a march on Jerusalem.³ This is the picture of the 'democratic' revolution that we are not supposed to see – at least according to our mainstream media. Meanwhile American warships confront Iranian ones in the Suez Canal, as Tehran continues to process nuclear fuel and talk about fomenting chaos to bring forth the Islamic messiah.⁴ The Muslim Brotherhood is behind much of the revolutionary activity, quietly – but steadily moving toward their ultimate goal; the establishment of a Caliphate or multi-national Muslim Religious state.

Then there's what's happening here in America. New reports find that, despite what we've been told by some of the Liberal media, the FBI has identified at least 61 entities tied to the Muslim Brotherhood within the US itself. These include: "*The Islamic Society of North America, or ISNA, the umbrella organization for most of the Muslim groups in the U.S. and Canada - The North American Islamic Trust, or NAIT, which holds title to most of the major mosques in America...and The Washington-based Council on American-Islamic Relations, or CAIR, the largest Muslim-rights group in the country.*"⁵ And of course there are the protests in Madison, Wisconsin. The states are going broke and those that try to deal with the hard choices will be faced with the reactions of a culture which has become accustomed to living beyond its means. It is public employee unions – this time – that are resistant to governments trying to get their budgets back into balance. Over 40 states face hard choices as they are billions of dollars behind in funding pensions and healthcare mandates. We are likely to see this scene repeated again and again in the months and years just ahead. The situation is coincidentally being taken advantage of by Leftists of all stripes. These include such throw-backs as the SDS (Students for a Democratic Society) of the 1960's – and the IWW (International Workers of the World) or Wobblies – a Communist / anarchist group founded in 1905. They are joined by more modern groups such as The Zapatista Army of National Liberation – another anarchist / revolutionary organization. And along with the reported evidence of rampant pot use among the radical elements – there was documented talk of revolution. A Youtube video showed one woman from *Chicago Revolution Magazine* who saw this as an opportunity to make "people open to possibilities of building a revolutionary movement."^{6,7} Now the media – and our government - would have us believe that all of these movements are but a triumph of man's democratic impulse. Yet even our Founding Fathers warned of the tendency of 'pure' democracy to degenerate into mob rule. That's why they set up a representative republic. Revolutions are funny things. They often have a life of their own. The Russian Revolution of 1917 turned from its liberal beginnings to a Communist led blood bath which murdered millions and machine-gunned the Czar and his family. The French Revolution ended in guillotines and excess and headless monarchs. Such is the way of Revolutions.

THE MUSLIM BROTHERHOOD: HISTORY & PROPHECY – PART II

Understanding the sources of any conflict is essential – not just to define its character; but also to properly evaluate the enemy we are facing. There is more to the Muslim Brotherhood than the mainstream media would have us believe. There is a darker side to Islam itself than is allowed in 'polite company'. And it all, eventually and inevitably cycles back to Israel and The Land and the promise to Abraham.

DER FURHER'S LEGACY

Adolph Hitler was an occult figure. His satanic handlers believed he was endowed with the Spirit of Antichrist. While Hitler may have failed to live up to the hopes of some in the occult who early on saw him as a candidate for the role of New Age Messiah; - he did leave a legacy that has tied in to the next generation of anti-Semites;- one that seeks the destruction of the Jewish race. It's now time to unfold the little-publicized, - yet clearly documented ties between the Nazis and Radical Islam; - the force that is committed to both the destruction of the Jewish State and the conquest and transformation of Western culture.

Mmmm, let's think! What do Hitler and the Nazis have in common with, let's say, Osama bin Laden and Hamas and Hezbollah and just about any other radical Islamist you would care to mention? Oh wait! I know! Pick me! Pick me! Let me tell you: It's that they both hated the Jewish people and were committed to their very destruction. Both became 'Cultures of Death', and fueled on hate they adapted virulent anti-Semitism as their overriding ethic. Dig at all beneath the surface and you find that that ethic is not only apparent – but direct. Unfortunately, that has been a point missed by the hand-wringing liberal media that instead sees such factors as Western Colonialism as the driving force behind radical Islam and terror. Yet the terrorists have indicted themselves by their own words. Here's bin-Laden in

1998: “The enmity between us and the Jews goes back far in time and is deep rooted... war between us is inevitable”. In a 2002 letter to America, the Terrorist in Chief refers to “the Jews who control your policies, media and economy”, accusing them of “...achieving their aims at your expense”.⁸ The rhetoric is more than reminiscent of the Hitlerian diatribes spewed out in Germany during the 1930’s: They are products of the same source. There is scant difference between the raging Nazi Holocaust and the ever-expanding practice of Jihad. As recently as 2002, Hitler’s *Mein Kampf* was # 6 on the best-seller list among Palestinian Arabs.⁹

The modern history of the movement dates back to about 1920 when a little known Arab, Haj Amin al Husseini led a bloody attack against Jews praying at the Wailing Wall.¹⁰ He was arrested, sentenced and released by the British and in 1922 appointed Grand Mufti of Jerusalem, and head of the Supreme Muslim Council.¹¹ It was Husseini who played sidekick to Hassan al-Banna, in getting the whole Arab / terror thing going. Al-Banna was the founder of the Muslim Brotherhood, which would become the granddaddy of today’s Arab terror movement. And oh yeah, - he started that too. He was a key force behind militant Islam and the concept of Arab nationalism; - a brand new player on the world scene. A campaign of terror and murder was introduced, especially against Jews, but also taking in Arabs that opposed the aims of the Brotherhood. Then in the early 1930’s as Hitler began his rise to power in Germany, the Muslim Brotherhood took on new life. Membership rose from about 800 to over 200,000 just before the outbreak of World War II. It was centered now in Egypt, where it sponsored mass demonstrations and violence against Jewish immigration. “Jews Get Out of Egypt and Palestine!” was their motto. An offshoot, the Young Egypt movement, like the Nazis staged torchlight processions with the slogan, “One folk, One part, One leader”.¹² The movement called for a new order based on Sharia law. Hassan al-Banna, its founder wrote that a nation that “perfects the industry of death” would be the recipient of God’s graces. So they adopted not only Nazi tactics, - but received Nazi funding through the German legation in Cairo. The fact is that the Muslim Brotherhood had managed to radicalize, - to use a modern term, - the Arab Street, by inculcating a culture of death and hatred for the Jew. Nazi-like formations of chanting radicalized Arabs marched through the streets, saluting this culture of death and chanting; - “We are not afraid of death, we desire it”.¹³

It’s no surprise then that when World War II broke out, these same Arabs became the natural allies of the Axis forces fighting the British and Americans in North Africa. It was Hitler’s plan to bring the Holocaust to the Middle East; a goal with which this radical Islamic movement wholly agreed. Syrians hit the streets to celebrate the Germans defeat of France in 1940. The Grand Mufti, Husseini, (Arafat’s uncle), went to Germany where he declared his goal to be the “destruction of Jewry living in” the Arab lands. He asked Hitler’s government to approve the extermination of Palestine’s Jewish population “along the lines used to settle the Jewish question in Germany”.¹⁴ Germany’s popular General Erwin Rommel was lionized in Arab lands, with people greeting each other with the salute: “Heil Rommel”. Although defeated before they were able to carry out their bloody work, a special unit of Rommel’s army was assigned the task of the murder of the resident Jewish population in Palestine. About 2,500 Tunisian Jews were exterminated by the Nazis there.¹⁵

It was during the struggle between Germans and British for El Alamein that Germany’s Arab allies in Palestine planned a major uprising against the British forces there. When that revolt failed, al Husseini, the Grand Mufti, escaped to Berlin, where he was hailed as the “Fuhrer of the Arabic World”. He went on to lobby for the extermination of Hungarian Jews, and against the exchange of 5,000 Jewish children for German POWs. Finally, he traveled to Bosnia, where he recruited a special Waffen SS unit which “slaughtered 90% of Bosnia’s Jews and burned countless Serbian churches and villages”. The Grand Mufti asked only one thing in return for his aid to the Nazi cause; - the liquidation of the entire Jewish population of Palestine.¹⁶ After the war, the Muslim Brotherhood grew in power in Egypt. The Arab lands became the center of worldwide anti-Semitism. This Islamic / Nazi movement conducted pogroms against the Jews there and al-Husseini himself lobbied for the 1948 Arab invasion of Israel.¹⁷

So what had begun as pre-WWII fascist politics had now morphed into the *raison d’etre* for the Islamic stance on Israel and eventually everything Western. They were aided along in this endeavor by the short-sighted, self-serving motives of the British Secret Service. Former member of the American Justice Department, John Loftus culled US government files and stumbled upon some amazing evidence. He reported it first for CBS’ 60 Minutes in 1982. After the war the British Secret Service wanted to employ the Muslim Brotherhood to take down the nascent Israeli state in 1948. French Intelligence cooperated, releasing the Grand Mufti from custody and arranging his transport to Egypt. Later on elements of American intelligence services joined the game. They all hoped to use these “Arab Nazis” against the burgeoning Communist movement in the Middle East.

It gets even more complicated. In the 1950’s, - as the Egyptians under Nasser clamped down on the Muslim Brotherhood, - the CIA arranged to move them to Saudi Arabia. There they set up Madrasas or religious schools that absorbed their own Islamic-Nazi doctrine. Thus was birthed modern Wahabbi Islam. Prior to 1900 it had been considered a weird and heretical cult even among mainstream Islam, - which history shows is not the most peaceful of religions. Now the Afghan Taliban and the Saudis are chief proponents of Wahabbism. In the 1970’s, when Russia was fighting the Afghans, the CIA got involved again. The US and the Saudis got together and arranged for the political / religious descendants of the Muslim Brotherhood, - these Islamo-Nazis, to take the field and drive out the Russians. Mission accomplished. Only the problem created may have been worse than the problem solved. It was these actions that made possible the rise to power of Osama bin Laden.¹⁸

We have seen bin Laden’s mind set. But there is an under-publicized connection with the 9/11 attack that provides another level of insight into that tragic attack; - a strange symmetric cosmic synergy that applies. It is interesting to note that the attack on the World Trade Center was coordinated from Germany. Mohammed Atta who drove the hijacked plane into the North Tower, 2 other pilots as well as several other of the 9/11 conspirators were members of an al-Qaeda cell that met in Hamburg, Germany. In a 9/11 trial, Atta’s worldview was described by one witness as a “National Socialist way of thinking”. That means that *he thought like a Nazi*. Atta believed that when they struck at New York they were striking at the heart of the Jewish conspiracy to control the world. It was testified that another of the conspirators, al-Motaassedeq, said “The Jews will burn and in the end we will dance on their graves”. Those anti-Semitic sentiments of the terrorists were never even reported in the American media.

Then, this final connection. Note the rants of Adolph Hitler himself, as recorded by his longtime confidant, Albert Speer. In his fantasies, Hitler envisioned New York skyscrapers turning into giant torches, a “disintegrating city in the dark sky”. It became part of his plan. From the middle of the war onward, Hitler planned to launch kamikaze type attacks against American cities. The Germans even designed a special bomber for the purpose; - The Daimler-Benz *Amerikabomber*.¹⁹ It was the dream of the supreme anti-Semite. That dream was bequeathed to his progeny; - The terrorists of our age; - al-Qaeda, & Hamas, & Hezbollah, and the nephew of the Grand Mufti himself, - the honored leader of the recently invented Palestinian people; - Yassir Arafat.

The Political Legacy

The political legacy of this Nazi / Islamic alliance is perhaps best expressed by the creation of the fiction that there is a Palestinian people entitled to a Palestinian State, carved out of Israel. World leaders like President Ahmadinejad of Iran tell us that this infestation of Jews which began returning in force in the 1880’s only robbed the land from its rightful owners; The Palestinian People. ‘If it wasn’t for Israel’, they reason, ‘there would be no Middle East problem’. Whether or not they believe it themselves; These people are telling a lie. There are not now, nor has there ever been a distinct group or a nation called the Palestinian People!

Amid much controversy and ridicule and charges of racism, former Israeli Prime Minister Golda Meir once declared: “There is no such thing as a Palestinian people”.²⁰ As politically incorrect as that statement was, it was one other thing: The absolute historical truth. The big myth that has been perpetrated tells us that Israel wrested the Land from the Palestinians occupying their homeland after wars of conquest. The fact is: Israel moved into the territories only after Arab countries initiated wars of annihilation against the Jewish presence. Those Arab countries included Egypt, Syria, Jordan, Lebanon, Saudi Arabia, Iraq and Yemen. Did you notice? No Palestine! It didn’t exist. In the entire period from Israel’s modern founding in 1948 until the end of the 6-Day War, in 1967, (during the whole time that Egypt controlled Gaza and Jordan held the West Bank), - no mention was ever made of the Palestinian People.²¹ Curiously and conveniently, they only found their voice after that disastrous war. So let’s look at the History of the Land.

In the beginning: There was no Palestine. The Israeli conquest took about 200 years beginning in 1200 BC. Before that Amalekites, Jebusites, Hittites, Amorites, and Canaanites among others, occupied the Land: - There were no Palestinians.²² Over time, as Israel struggled in their commitment to God, they struggled to maintain control of the land. Babylonians, Persians, Hasmoneans and Romans took their turns at ruling The Holy Land. Back around 63 BC, Rome turned the formerly independent Israel into an administrative district they renamed Palestine. (Since that time, all the peoples who would occupy the Land became known as Palestinians; - whether Greeks, Arabs or Jews.) In time the Caesars grew tired of an Israel always in revolt against Rome. In AD 70 and again in 135, Roman legions destroyed Jerusalem and dispersed hundreds of thousands of Jews into all the nations of the world. Yet through the centuries, a remnant always remained. In the centuries that followed came Byzantine Greeks, the conquering armies of Islam, the Crusaders, Mamluks, Ottoman Turks, and after WWI, - the British. Then in 1948, Israel regained a part of the Land.²³ The fact is The Jews have had a continuous presence there for 33 centuries. Jerusalem has been the Jewish capital since that time. Mohammed never once even visited the Holy City. In fact it wasn’t until 635 AD that conquering Islamic armies, wrested control from its legitimate Jewish owners. So any Islamic claim can date only back to the 7th century; - while the Jewish presence always remained, even under Islamic occupation.

‘REASON’ TO BELIEVE – PART VI

[After that meander through some reasons for the validity of Biblical Truth, it’s time to get more serious about the subject. Recall back to the start of this series, one of the challenges that we looked at came from the scientific community. Many scientists have built their belief’s on a system that denies the supernatural and posits that ‘Everything That Is’ – came from – ‘Nothing Whatsoever’. They affirm that everything must have a cause – until that is – they come to the existence of anything at all; at which time they abandon the principle altogether. While searching for design and causation throughout the process of scientific investigation, they deny its utility at the point it is most needed – the very beginning. On the face of it, this is a very difficult position to defend. Ah, but I’ve tipped my hand.]

This is a controversy that rages in the church, our education system and society at large. In this section of our series we will examine ‘Intelligent Design’, the near hysterical opposition to it, and the merits of the theory itself. Ultimately we are left to choose between purposeless evolution and the design of a loving and caring God to explain our existence. Whichever we chose has a bearing not only on the shape of society here on earth, but more importantly on our eternal destiny!

THAT’S THE WAY IT IS!.....?

“For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown *it* to them. For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse, because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.” (Romans 1:18-21)

Scientists are very sure when it comes to the theory of intelligent design! It just depends on their understanding though, as to exactly what they are sure of. The Reverend George Coyne, the Vatican’s chief astronomer, is very sure that, “Intelligent design isn’t science even though it pretends to be.” He further opined that it should only be taught as part of cultural history or religion. Citing “modern science”, Rev. Coyne said, “...believers must move away from the notion of a ...designer God”. However his boss, Pope Benedict begs to differ, stating the universe was the result of an “intelligent project”.²⁴ And so it goes.

But just what is “intelligent design”? In simple terms it is the theory that the origin of; 1) The Universe, 2) Its Characteristics, and 3) Life Itself, can best be explained to be the result of directed, intelligent causation rather than the accidental processes of Neo-Darwinian evolution. In a nutshell it says, *‘Something doesn’t come from nothing. And something with a design doesn’t come about by accident’*. There has to be a designer. In contrast, the theory of evolution says that the design found in nature is only an illusion. Saving detail for later, intelligent design (ID), has harnessed the methods of various scientific disciplines, (anthropology, forensics, cryptography etc) to detect evidence that a phenomena was the result of intelligent causation. It’s the type of thing done all the time, - in police work for instance, to determine if a death was accidental or a homicide. But of course it is the implications of the evidence that leads to controversy.²⁵ It challenges the very basis of modern science; - the assumption that ‘Nature’ is all there is.

Speaking for the scientific community, Wikipedia characterizes the movement as “[neocreationist pseudoscience](#) or [junk science](#)”.²⁶ Writing for NPR, Jeffrey Dvorkin argues that the question of higher purpose “...is about many things, but ultimately, it is not about rationalism”. Mr. Dvorkin cannot see how science and faith can possibly be mixed. Because after all, being irrational in its very nature, faith “defies explanation”.²⁷ In fact it is the position of the modernist, atheistic, naturalistic powers that claim intellectual authority in our society, that science and religion each have their own sphere, - thereby drawing a distinction that cannot rationally exist. If there is Truth, it must be real. It must accurately portray the way things are in the real world. Instead science has arrogated to itself the authority to define truth. It claims this power under what it sees as the unchallenged authority of naturalism.²⁸ Science is saying, - that what is real is all that matters, and that all that is real can only be defined by science. Naturalism is a closed system. It describes a world in which ‘all that came to be’, is the result of natural causes, the product of material cause and effect. There is no room in that line of thinking for the God of creation. God is defined out of the equation.

Some, like Harvard genetics professor Richard Lewontin defend the scientific position with revealing honesty. “The problem”, he says, “is to get them to reject irrational and supernatural explanations of the world, the demons that exist only in their imaginations, and to accept ...science as the only begetter of truth. We exist as material beings in a material world, all of whose phenomena are the consequences of material relations among material entities.”²⁹ Under this mode of thinking, God may be acceptable as a subjective tool, but He can have no basis in reality. God is but a relic of the darkened past, before science enlightened mankind to the true nature of his purposeless existence. Under this system, God is therefore a figment of our wishful collective imagination. Lewontin further admits in the same article, [Now get this!], - that it is not the compelling nature of the evidence that leads to such a conclusion but prior commitment to processes “...that produce material explanations.” In that admission, the good professor reveals the movement’s ultimate weakness: It is committed to an evolutionary explanation despite the evidence! This is atheism posing as science!

Observe their tortured logic. Materialism by definition excludes the consideration of outside forces. It can only follow then that a creative outside force, i.e. God, must by assumption be excluded. In effect it is saying; *‘When we consider the origin of man and the cosmos, we will only consider natural, material causes. Aha! We have found that man is the product of natural material causes alone.’* Fettered by their assumptions, they are forced to deny the increasing weight of scientific evidence coming to light in so many areas of inquiry; evidence that points to patterns of intelligent design in the universe and its component parts. That circular logic is pregnant with serious societal implications.³⁰

Here are some of those implications to try on for size. If we are but products of an accidental universe, then for all practical purposes: God is dead. If God is dead: There is no Truth, - because there is no source for ultimate truth. If there is no Truth: There is no basis for morality. What this prior commitment to evolution has turned into is a philosophical religious creed that defines the parameters of modern thought. God then becomes simply a human invention. Life is the simple result of purposeless cause and effect. Naturalism is the rule and exclusively defines rational thought. Therefore any consideration of the supernatural is out of order. If we are products of purposeless, happy coincidence, then all definition of morality, of the value of life, - is by right and logic, ours to make. It is the ultimate in liberation theology. If we are but cosmic accidents, what then is our ultimate purpose and value? With this philosophy in place, Professor Peter Singer can argue for the ‘right’ to terminate the life of severely handicapped children during the first month of life. Who can deny Gay marriage or polygamy? And what’s wrong with incest, anyway? Where does one rationally draw that line once you have removed God, (the source of Truth and morality) from His throne? If all science is reality and religion is merely subjective, then morality is individual and God has no place in the public life of the republic. So in debate, - the religious are swept to the fringe, - the kook fringe.

Those naturalist assumptions are firmly entrenched in our educational system. Esteemed historian, Philip Johnson argues powerfully that naturalism has become the quasi-official religious philosophy of the United States. It certainly has established itself as the guiding force in public education. Johnson points out that “...the power of the federal judiciary, and the mystique of the Constitution, vigorously and almost always successfully, insists that law and public education must be based upon naturalistic assumptions.”³¹ Now naturalism, and the Neo-Darwinian explanation of the origin of man, lies in direct opposition to the notion of the existence of God. As everything is explained in terms of ‘natural causes’, it renders belief in God impossible. It attacks the notion of design in the construct of both the cosmos and the biological systems that support life here on earth. This is a philosophy of the accidental. There can be no designing God. The world as we know it, is the sum of all the accidental interactions that preceded it. The atheistic assumption is not lost on the students.³² Cornell biologist William Provine admitted the implications of pure naturalism in debate. Darwinism means, said he; “No life after death; No ultimate foundation for ethics; No ultimate meaning for life; No free will.”³³ These then are the implications of the philosophy taught in our schools. But is this the truth? Increasingly scientists are saying, ‘It is not!’. Next time we will look at just how science is increasingly beginning to question those underlying assumptions of Darwinian Theory.
